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About The TCOA Data Privacy Policy (top)

This policy lets you know what happens to any personal data that you give the Tinker Class Owners Association (the TCOA), how we use it, how it is secured, and your rights in relation to it.

We may change this policy from time to time by updating this document to reflect changes in the law or changes in the way we manage your data.

We will always comply with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) when dealing with your personal data. Further information on GDPR can be found at the website for the Information Commissioner's Office (www.ico.org.uk).

What is the source of your personal information? (top)

We only collect personal information from you directly. This will either be taken from a TCOA membership form, or from an e-mail you have sent us.

How do we protect your personal data? (top)

We will not transfer your personal data outside the European Economic Area without your consent.

We have implemented generally accepted standards of technology and operational security in order to protect personal data from loss, misuse or unauthorised alteration or destruction.

It should be noted that when you are transferring information to us over the internet or via e-mail this can never be guaranteed 100% secure.

As a volunteer organisation without a base or home club, all data processing is undertaken on personal computers and personal devices. Wherever possible, cloud storage and processing is used, but there will be instances where data is stored on personal devices. All members involved with data processing have been informed about device security and password protection.

We will notify you promptly in the event of any breach of your personal data.

Who has access to your information? (top)

- The TCOA Membership Secretary for TCOA membership management.
- The TCOA Rally Secretary and his/her assistant(s) for organising rallies and other Tinker related events.
- The TCOA Sailing Secretary and his/her assistant(s)—for recording racing results.
- The TCOA Webmaster for advising members of updates to the TCOA website and for Marketplace advertising.
- The TCOA Data Protection Officer for reviewing TCOA data protection processes.

Who else has access to the information you provide us? (top)

We will never sell your personal data. We will not share your personal data with any third parties without your prior consent (which your are free to withdraw at any time) except where we are required to do so by law, as set out in the <u>table above</u>, and as detailed in the following paragraph.

We may pass your personal data to third parties who are service providers, agents, and subcontractors to the TCOA for the purposes of completing tasks and providing services to you on our behalf (for example, the printing and mailing of the Travelogue magazine). We only disclose the personal data that is necessary for the third party to deliver the service and we will have an agreement in place that requires them to keep your information secure and not to use it for their own purposes.

How long do we keep your information? (top)

For TCOA members we will hold your personal data on our systems for as long as you are a member of the TCOA and for a period of 36 months after you cease to be a member, or for as long as we are required to comply with our legal obligations, whichever is longer. We will review your personal data annually to confirm we are still entitled to process it. If we decide we are not entitled to do so, we will stop processing your personal data except that we will retain your personal data in an archived form in order to be able to comply with any future legal obligations.

Records of your race positions and trophies awarded will be retained in the club archives both whilst you are a member and after you have resigned your membership from the TCOA.

Records of any positions you have held as an officer or committee member of the TCOA will be retained in the club archives both whilst you are a member and after you have resigned your membership from the TCOA.

We do not record or keep any of your financial information. We do not record or keep your bank account details.

For non TCOA members advertising on the website's Marketplace, we will hold your personal data for the duration of the advert. Following the sale of the item or the removal of the advert from the website, the details of your advert and payment amount will be retained in an archived form in order to be able to comply with any future legal obligations.

What are your rights? (top)

You have rights under the General Data Protection Regulation. You have:

- The right to be be informed about the collection and use of your personal data.
- The right of access to view your personal and supplementary data we hold.
- The right to rectification where the data we hold is inaccurate.
- In certain circumstances the right to have your personal data erased.
- In certain circumstances the right to restrict or suppress processing of your personal data.
- The right to data portability which allows you to obtain and reuse your personal data for your own purposes across different services.
- The right to object to processing based on legitimate interests or the performance of a task in the public interest/exercise of official authority.
- Rights related to automated decision making including profiling.

You have the right to take any complaints about how we process your personal data to the Information Commissioner – www.ico.org.uk/concerns.
